

One City One Book, Livonia Library Commission Video Submission Rules

1. Entries can be video commentary, scripted content, poetry, song, multimedia presentations, interview, skit, public service announcement but must be in a digital video format.
2. Each entry must focus on one or more of the following themes. You may discuss what this theme means to you, how you embody this theme in your own life, or how we can foster an environment that brings this theme to life.
 1. Identity
 2. Belonging
 3. Inclusivity
3. Only one student will be awarded each prize. You may work with others in creating your content, but there must only be one person's name on the entry.
4. Students who enter should be between the ages of 13-18.
5. This contest is limited to students of Livonia Public Schools and Clarenceville Public Schools.
6. The length of the video should be between 3 minutes and 5 minutes.
7. All entries should begin with a "title screen" that includes the following information:
 1. Students name
 - a. School name
 - a. Title of video
 - b. There is no entry fee.
 - c. All entries must be submitted in mp4 format.
 - d. Entries should be submitted via Dropbox Transfer to email address nlomas@livoniapubliclibrary.org starting on June 15, 2021. The deadline for submissions is 5:00 pm (eastern time, US) on Friday, September 3, 2021. Winners will be announced no later than Friday, September 17, 2021.

8. Submitting to this contest assumes consent by the entrant/the entrant's legal guardians for the City of Livonia/Livonia Public Library to share their submissions with the public via social media and City websites.
9. The judges' decision is final. Entries will be judged by the three Library Commissioners, the Library Director, and a Teen Services Librarian.
10. The only compensation for submitting a video is the opportunity to be awarded a prize if the entry wins.
11. Submissions are limited to one entry per student.
12. Awards will be presented as follows:
1st Place- \$250

2nd Place- \$150

3rd Place- \$100
