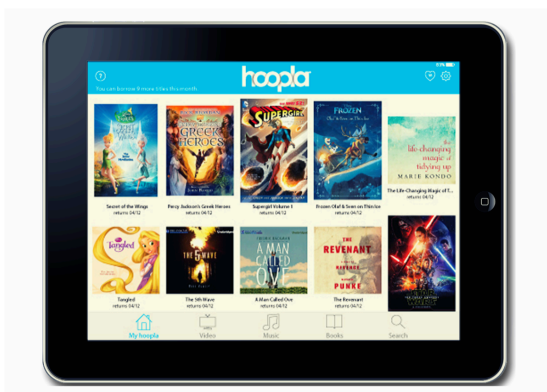
COVID-19 Update - Stay Connected

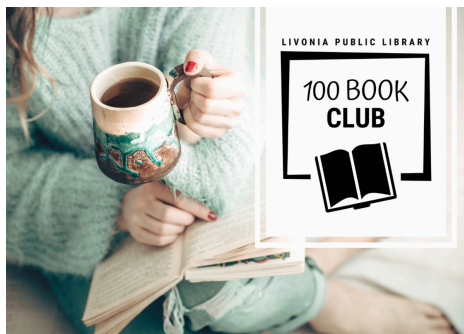

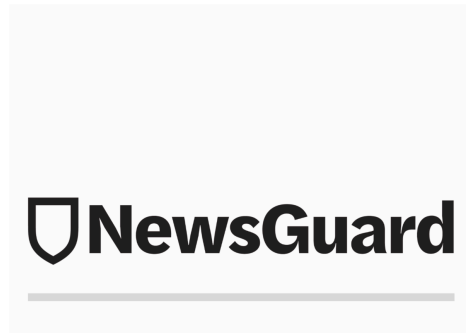
